Just like Peter and the rest of the disciples, we speak many a time in the flesh not knowing what we say. I am talking about sincere and matured believers and leaders. In a moment of emotion and fleshly nature, we say many things. But when the time comes to own what we said, we fail miserably. The reason is, as Jesus says "The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak" Mark 14:38. The only way to make the spirit stronger and the flesh weaker is spending hours in prayers. There is no short cut for this. In prayer, our flesh will be made to yield to the spirit. If flesh takes over the spirit in our life, then we will not have revelations of God's dealings in our life and we will speak all sorts of things which may not necessarily be God's thoughts. Prayer will water your spirit to be strengthened.
